HELD AT CITY HALL, MAY 2, 2022 AT 7:00 P.M.**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jack Poll.

Present: Councilmembers DeKryger, Fitzgerald, Postema, Postler, Vanderwood, Mayor Poll.

Councilmember DeKryger moved, seconded by Councilmember Vanderwood, to excuse Councilmember Bolt from the meeting.

Motion carried: 6 Yeas 0 Nays

The minutes of the April 18, 2022 Regular Meeting were approved by unanimous consent.

City Manager Holt asked that the Tri-Unity school presentation be moved ahead of the budget public hearing.

Councilmember Fitzgerald moved, seconded by Councilmember Postema, to approve the agenda as amended.

Budget Amendment No. 77 – To appropriate \$112,000 of additional budgetary authority to provide funding for the mailings and aerial spray services for the Spongy Moth Suppression Program

Councilmember Vanderwood moved, seconded by Councilmember Postema, to approve the preceding Budget Amendments.
