AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL CITY CODE CHAPTER 6 ENTITLED “ANIMALS” ENABLING KENT COUNTY’S ENFORCEMENT OF THE COUNTY DOG LAW WITHIN THE CITY; TO AMEND CITY CODE SECTION 1-2 BY ADDING DEFINITIONS; TO AMEND CITY CODE CHAPTER 50, ARTICLE IV, DIVISION 1 BY ADDING SECTIONS 50-127 THROUGH 50-132; TO AMEND CITY CODE CHAPTER 50, ARTICLE V, DIVISION 1 BY ADDING SECTION 50-171; AND TO AMEND CITY CODE CHAPTER 50, ARTICLE VII BY ADDING SECTION 50-269 RELATED TO CERTAIN ANIMALS AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS
(Final Reading)
