AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR IMPROVING THE EXISTING WATER SYSTEM OF THE CITY; TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CITY ORDINANCES; TO AUTHORIZE ISSUING AND SELLING ADDITIONAL SERIES OF WATER SYSTEM REVENUE BONDS; TO PRESCRIBE THE FORM OF THE BONDS; TO PROVIDE FOR COLLECTION OF REVENUES TO PAY WATER SYSTEM OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE COSTS; TO SEGREGATE AND DISTRIBUTE CERTAIN WATER SYSTEM REVENUES; TO PROVIDE A RESERVE FUND, FOR RIGHTS OF THE HOLDERS OF THE WATER SYSTEM REVENUE BONDS; AND FOR OTHER MATTERS RELATED TO THE ISSUANCE OF WATER SYSTEM REVENUE BONDS (Immediate Effect)

Councilmember Postema moved, seconded by Councilmember DeKryger, that the above Ordinance be adopted and that the Ordinance be published in the Official Newspaper of the City.
