BUDGET AMENDMENTS

Budget Amendment No. 44 – To appropriate an additional \$14,000 of budgetary authority to provide the necessary funds for salaries to maintain the Court and City Hall buildings

Budget Amendment No. 45 – To appropriate an additional \$180,000 of budgetary authority to provide the necessary funds for increased costs related to power for streetlighting

Budget Amendment No. 46 – To appropriate an additional \$115,000 of budgetary authority for the blower project and to recognize the associated investment revenue

Budget Amendment No. 47 – To appropriate an additional \$163,000 of budgetary authority for water bond payments and to recognize the associated transfer from the Water Fund
