The Clerk introduced Ordinance 12-26:

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE IV, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO AMEND DIVISION 2, SECTION 2-258 AND SECTION 2-259 TO MODIFY EXISTING PROCUREMENT STANDARDS (Final Reading)

Councilmember Arnoys moved, seconded by Councilmember DeKryger, that the above Ordinance be adopted and that the Ordinance be published in the Official Newspaper of the City.

Councilmember Postema moved, seconded by Councilmember Hill, to amend the Ordinance to modify the maximum costs the City Manager may approve related to projects approved in the annual CIP from up to \$250,000 to up to \$150,000.

It was confirmed that this would change Section 2-259 to read:

“For services related to projects approved in the annual CIP, the City Manager may approve costs associated with the project up to \$150,000 before seeking authorization from Council for additional spending.”

Motion carried: 7 Yeas 0 Nays

The Mayor called the main motion that the above Ordinance, as amended, be adopted and that the Ordinance be published in the Official Newspaper of the City.
