AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 14, ARTICLE VI, OF THE CITY CODE TO PROHIBIT MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS AND FACILITIES IN THE CITY (First Reading)

The Clerk introduced Ordinance 2-19:

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 50, ARTICLE V, DIVISION 2, OF THE CITY CODE BY AMENDING SECTIONS 50-188 AND 50-190, AND ADDING SECTION 50-191 TO PROHIBIT DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF MARIHUANA, TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THAT DIVISION, AND TO ADDRESS POTENTIAL CONFLICTS BETWEEN THAT PROVISION AND APPLICABLE STATE LAWS (Emergency Adoption)

Councilmember Vanderwood moved, seconded by Councilmember Bolt, that Ordinance 1-19 be considered for its first reading, that Ordinance 2-19 be considered for emergency adoption, that the Ordinances be considered as read and that the Ordinances be published in the Official Newspaper of the City.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE IV, DIVISION 7, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY REPEALING SECTIONS 2-301A – 2-310E AND BY AMENDING SECTIONS 2-306 – 2-310 TO PROVIDE FOR A SERVICE CHARGE IN LIEU OF TAXES FOR THE 28WPHASEONE LIMITED DIVIDEND HOUSING ASSOCIATION LIMITED PARTNERSHIP HOUSING PROJECT (First Reading)

Councilmember Postler moved, seconded by Councilmember Postema, that the above Ordinance be considered for its first reading, that the Ordinance be considered as read and that the Ordinance be published in the Official Newspaper of the City.
