

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE REGULAR WYOMING CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
HELD AT CITY HALL, APRIL 20, 2020 AT 7:00 P.M.**

The minutes of the April 6, 2020 Regular Meeting were approved by unanimous consent.

City Manager Holt noted that a proposed resolution had been distributed to Councilmembers to urge Governor Whitmer and the legislature to collaboratively develop a phased plan to restore services and economic activity based on multi-factored risk evaluation. As there was support for this resolution, Mayor Poll added it to the agenda as Resolution R.
